

The American Legion Auxiliary Laurel Girls State Code of Conduct

I acknowledge following the expectations and rules outlined in the Code of Conduct below:

1. I acknowledge that I am participating in a program focused on the democratic process, government, patriotism, and Americanism at my own will. I agree to participate in the expected activities during the week but will not be forced into any situation with which I am uncomfortable.
2. I acknowledge I am representing my school and hometown at ALA LGS.
3. We are guests of the University of New Haven. Therefore, University regulations will apply. The University asks that we do NOT remove any furnishings from the residence halls, utilize bulletin boards when campaigning rather than walls or woodwork, and remember that all buildings on campus are smoke-free. Citizens are responsible for the cleanliness of their residence hall rooms and all valuables brought.
4. Please be considerate of those around you. If tension or conflict occurs and you cannot resolve it, please see your Counselor immediately.
5. No writing or defacing candidates' posters will be on the walls during campaigns.
6. Any illness or injury, even minor ones, must be reported to your counselor.
7. Citizens must attend all sessions and ceremonies. They will attend all activities as a group and be supervised by a counselor.
8. You must wear your name badge at all times. All personal belongings, such as suitcases, instruments, etc., must also be marked.
9. There is a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for drugs, alcohol, harassment, or instruments of harm. Any infraction of the rules will automatically result in a call to your parents and removal from the program.
10. Citizens must be in their rooms by the assigned times on their delegates' schedules.
11. Boys State Delegates and Girls State Delegates are not permitted to enter each other's suites or bedrooms at any time. Any infraction of this rule will automatically result in a call to your parents and removal from the program.
12. Once the program begins, visitors are not allowed. Parents are invited to watch closing ceremonies but may not sit with delegates. Any personal visits from outsiders are grounds for immediate dismissal.
13. Delegates may not leave campus at any time. If you need anything throughout the week, speak to Jessica Abel (Chairman/Director) or Nancy Hansen (Store Manager), and they will arrange to get it for you.

I agree to abide by any other regulations proposed by ALA LGS staff to promote safety during the program. I acknowledge that if I break any of the above rules, I may be removed from the program and will be required to pay the full cost of the program back to the sponsoring organization.
